



## Your Safety & Comfort

- TEMSCO primarily operates a tour fleet of Astar turbine helicopters designed for their quiet ride, and fabulous views from every seat.
- Weather in Southeast Alaska can change quickly, and it is often colder on the glaciers. We recommend you dress warmly with layers of clothing and bring raingear if needed. Glacier boots are provided. Don't forget your camera, sunglasses, hat and gloves.
- No Bags will be allowed in the helicopters due to safety regulations. A secure storage area will be provided for personal items.
- Tour times are approximate and include both helicopter time and time on the glacier. Flight routes and landing locations may vary due to weather and glacier conditions.
- Due to weight and balance limitations, guests weighing 250 lbs. or more will be asked to pay an additional surcharge and will be provided extra space in the helicopter.
- TEMSCO Helicopters operates under a Forest Service Special Use Permit in the Tongass National Forest.

TEMSCO Helicopters, Inc.'s maintenance departments are fully-staffed FAA repair stations and manufacturer's service centers for the aircraft models in our fleet. Our technicians are regularly trained by the manufacturers, continuing their skills at the leading edge of technology, and allowing them to maintain our aircraft to the highest levels of safety and reliability.



**T.O.P.S.:** All tours are conducted under the Helicopter Tour Operators Program of Safety (T.O.P.S.). These are the best management practices for making our safety the top priority.

**TBMP:** This program is a cooperative effort of Juneau tour operators, cruise lines, transportation providers and the City and Borough of Juneau (CBJ). Tourism Best Management Practices (TBMP) are intended to minimize the impacts of tourism in a manner which addresses both resident and industry concerns.

**Fly Neighborly Program:** Helicopter operators agree to conduct flightseeing tours in accordance with the Helicopter Association International (HAI) Fly Neighborly Program. The Fly Neighborly Program is a voluntary noise reduction program designed to be implemented worldwide by local helicopter operators both large and small. Operators will train all pilots on the Fly Neighborly Program with regard to its application to local operations. Your flight takes you over the glacier itself; the helicopter's perspective giving you an eagle's-eye view of ice spires, deep blue crevasses and meltwater pools. Descending towards our landing site, you may fly past the Mendenhall Towers-rock sentinels that soar to nearly 7,000 feet!

A gentle landing brings you to the ice itself, where you'll explore the glacier's surface with our highly-experienced, knowledgeable guides. Bring plenty of film or memory cards and batteries - this is a wonderful opportunity to take once-in-a-lifetime photos. Binoculars are a good bet too, as you never know when you'll have a chance to see some of Alaska's famous wildlife!

Duration: Tour includes approximately 30 minutes of helicopter time and approximately 20-25 minutes will be spent on the glacier, for a total time of 50-55 minutes. Please allow up to 45 minutes for transportation and the safety briefing. Glacier boots are provided.

## ***Pilot's Choice Glacier Explorer Tour - Juneau***

Take our "PILOT'S CHOICE" Glacier Explorer Tour, for a second-to-none journey to see the best Alaska has to offer. Your pilot will give you an eagle's-eye view of high alpine lakes, "icefalls" hanging from sheer cliffs and some of the most remote peaks and glaciers in the Juneau Icefield - places like Wonderland, Glacier King, the Mendenhall Towers, and Devil's Paw. The itinerary is flexible; your pilot is free to create the best possible tour under the current weather and glacier conditions.

For an up-close opportunity to appreciate this ancient landscape, your pilot will land in two different locations, where you will continue the tour on foot! During these two landings you will learn about the geological and environmental processes at work creating moraines, crevasses, seracs, and the glaciers themselves.

The "Pilot's Choice" tour is an incomparable journey of discovery, a once-in-a-lifetime experience sure to provide enduring memories of Southeast Alaska's beautiful wilderness.

Duration: Tour includes approximately 50 minutes of helicopter time and two separate landings of approximately 15 minutes each, for a total tour duration of 80 minutes. Please allow up to 45 minutes for transportation and the safety briefing. Approximately 30 minutes of the 80-minute tour will be spent on the National Forest System Lands. Glacier boots are provided.

## ***Glacier Discovery by Helicopter - Skagway***

Leave all traces of civilization behind and experience the infinite beauty of Alaska's remote glaciers. Lift off from the historic Skagway waterfront and head into a rugged region of sheer mountains, majestic valleys and massive glaciers. Jagged peaks towering over the Chilkat Glacier, cascading waterfalls, surrounding the Ferebee Glacier, or the spectacular "river of ice" known as the Meade Glacier, may be among the wonders you encounter. Flight routes and landing zones are selected daily to ensure that you receive the best that the area has to offer.

Once you have reached your destination, you will be given the rare opportunity to explore one of Mother Nature's greatest marvels. Enjoy a walking tour-of-a-lifetime as our experienced glacier guides answer all of your questions and work to explain the awesome forces at work.

Duration: Tour includes approximately 40 minutes of helicopter time and 40 minutes on the glacier, for a total time of 1 hour, 20 minutes. Please allow up to 30 minutes for transportation and the safety briefing. Times will vary due to weather and glacier conditions. Glacier boots and safety vests are provided.
