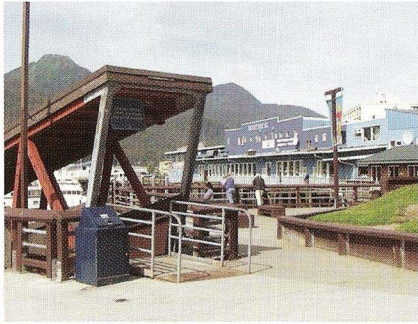


HOW TO FIND US

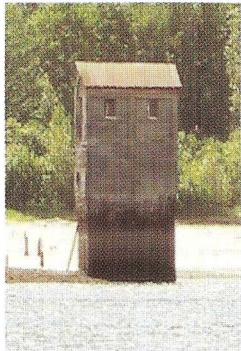

The Mines

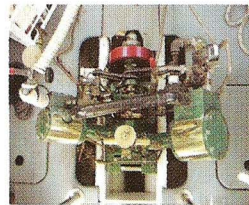


During your hour long cruise, you will be taken back to the turn of the century, when Alaska was still a wild frontier! You will learn how early miners overcame incredible obstacles to create the largest Hard Rock Gold mine (the Treadwell) in

its time. You will learn about other Juneau mines, each with its own unique story, as well as the miners and the amazing engineering feats they accomplished to create these mines.

While on your tour, your guide will discuss the history of the Mexican, the 700, the Ready Bullion, the Perseverance, and the Alaska-Juneau mine, pointing out some of the remnants of these mines. These mines produced over seven million ounces of gold between 1880 and 1944. You will also learn about the development of hydroelectric power used to support the mines.

The Steamboat



On the tour, our captain will show you the workings of a real steam engine, and explain the mechanics behind what makes this unique boat work.

Just as the early miners did, you will have a chance to travel the Gastineau Channel in a genuine wood fired steamboat. Our steamboats are similar to the steamboat Marion, which ran between Douglas Island and the city of Juneau at the turn of the century! Our steamboats are the only wood burning passenger steamboats in the state of Alaska, making this a one of a kind tour that you are sure to remember!

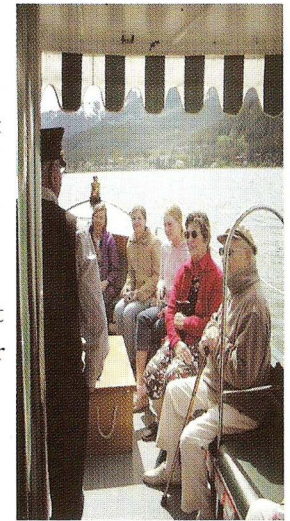


The People
